4. Judging will be based upon taste, consistency, ingredients, and appearance.
5. Contestant sign-in will be held on **Saturday, June 12, 2010, at 4:30 PM** in The Grange Building.
6. Professional chefs, cooks, food stylists, and other food specialists are prohibited from entering this contest.
7. Lazy Pierogi prepared by the contestants will be judged by a panel of three judges, beginning at **5 PM**.
8. Trophies will be awarded for first-, second-, and third-place winners. Winners will have the opportunity to submit their recipe for publication in the Polish Union of America News.
